AGE REQUIRMENTS as of Jan. 1, 2025:

- Open Race is available to Riders 19 and under.
- Average Side Pot is available to Riders 19 and under.
- Teen Side Pot is available to Riders 13-19.
- Youth Side Pot is available to Riders 12 and under.
- Pony Class is available to Riders 12 and Under.

STALLS AND HOOKUPS:

- Reserved by payment only and by order of payment as received by office.
- Refunds for Stalls and H/U's will be based upon our ability to resell them. You may resale on your own. Please make sure that your buyer knows they will be under your name.
- To have stalls and hookups together please send in together.
- The facility offers Newer Stall barns and older stall barns. The newer barns will be filled 1st by order of payment.
- Nearly all hook ups have full access to Electric, Waters and Sewer. There are 30 amp and 50 amp. If you prefer a 50 please notate that with your reservations. We cannot guarantee everyone to get a 50 that request but will do our best.
- If you have special request to be with someone please note that with your reservation. We cannot guarantee request will be met but will do our best.
- As Stalls and H/U's are reserved by payment as received by home office, we recommend you make your reservations online. You can always send your entries in via mail later.

Pony Class:

- Available to Riders 12 & Under as of Jan. 1.
- Available to Ponies 52 inches and under, measuring from back of the leg to the top of the withers.
- Please make sure your pony meets these requirements. We would hate to have to turn away ponies at the show but be advised these rules will be followed.

Class Entries:

- Reservations and Entries open 02/14/25.
- Mail in Pre-Entry deadline is May 16. Online Pre-Entry deadline is May 23rd.
- After Pre-Entry deadlines there is a late fee of \$50 per horse.
- Entries at show will be Cash or Card only.
- Full Refunds for Entries will be made due to death, sale or injury through May 23rd less the processing fee.
- After May 23rd 70% Refund due to death or injury with doctor or veterinarian release less processing fee and late fee. No refunds after class has started.
- Horse Changes can be made prior to first go. Same horse must be ran in the 2nd go and finals as ran in the first go.

Tie Rules: In the event of a tie in the Finals for Division Champions ONLY, the money for 1st/2nd place will be combined then divided equally. There will then be a run off for the Title of Champion or Reserve Champion and their perspective awards. If you choose not to run off you forfeit Champion and will be awarded Reserve Champion. If neither contestant wishes to run off the tie will be split via coin toss.

Dress Code: Short sleeve collared shirts and/or show t-shirts in each long go or full dress if you prefer. Short Go (Finals) must be in full dress code, long sleeve button down shirts. Hat Fines: \$5 hat fine is to be paid directly to the staff members that picked up your hat. You may not send anyone into the arena to pick up your hat.
